The Production Supervisor is responsible for ensuring all operations for manufacturing and packaging are planned and carried out efficiently to meet production deadlines to ensure our customers receive quality products and outstanding service.

A day in the life of the Production Supervisor at Virox will include...

- Supervising all areas of production, including batching, filling lines, and all offline activities (ex: box labelling).
- Coaching and training staff on all aspects of each line.
- Working with the Director of Production to set production schedules and ensuring production schedules are running on time and all deadlines are met.
- Working with Director of Production to plan labour needs to maximize efficiencies.
- Keeping staff motivated and inspired to produce quality products in a timely manner.
- Working with the Director of Production to address staffing and performance issues as they arise.
- Confirming all necessary production resources are available and staged appropriately to meet production demands.
- Performing minor equipment adjustments and repairs.
- Performing waste water treatment duties of waste water tanks.
- Inspecting filling equipment and containers to ensure safe and effective functioning of the equipment.
- Cleaning and regenerating equipment, DI and RO water systems, as required and documenting the inspections, reporting any issues to the Director of Production.
- Inspecting products on the line to ensure that items are capped and appropriate labels are attached to the containers and cases in accordance with Quality Assurance and Regulatory procedures.
- Completing required production process documentation is filled out in accordance with Quality Assurance and Regulatory procedures.
- Other tasks and projects as assigned.

- Diploma or degree in mechanical process engineering and/or chemical engineering.
- 3-5 years of previous supervisory experience in a manufacturing environment; previous experience in a chemical manufacturing and/or ISO 9001/14001 environment is considered an asset.

- Knowledge and demonstrated experience with LEED friendly practices is considered a strong asset.
- Experience using Microsoft Great Plains ERP, Excel and MRP.
